# Program Overview

LLTC has a strong emphasis in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM). The NSTI program will allow us to collaborate with the

- **Provide a brief essay (Why students wants to participate in the STI and how it can assist in meeting individual career goals)**
- **Provide transcript**
