Our library collection contains several hundred Anishinaabe, American Indian, and Indigenous titles. Our archives contain documents, local and regional newspapers articles, and other materials regarding the tribal college, the surrounding community and Minnesota reservations. We have a small collection of audiocassettes of elders, videotapes of local events, manuscripts from local writers, and several maps. Library Improvements / Acquisitions during academic year AY 03-04 AY 04-05 Increased reference section 100%. Brought in 25 databases for students and staff. K-12 through undergrad research quality. AY 05-06 Approximately 200 new STEM and Indigenous STEM-related print resources relating to LLTC's STEM curriculum have been purchased. The Director of Library Services attended the American Library Association conference. NSF-STEM funds allowed the library to purchase a well-needed office supply, a book cart, to transport and display STEM resources, in AY 06-07 addition to aid in daily shelving duties. The library implemented new technologies, including a new online public access catalog with long-term cost-effective subscription costs to increase the visibility, access, and usability of materials, including and especially the growing STEM collection. Library STEM subscriptions increased by 50%, including a subscription to Science, introducing students to AY 07-08 mainstream academic science journals. The library increased its STEM holdings by approximately 100 new titles and its Indigenous-related titles by 80 titles. Beginning January 2009, the library has developed and AY 08-09 implemented a blog available at http://lltclibrary.blogspot.com. The library increased its holdings by approximately 200 items from in-kind donations and \$2,500 in CSREES/NIFA funds.
