

### MISSION

The mission of the Leech Lake Tribal College Student Princess and Brave Program is to promote, recruit, remind, and provide educational opportunities to outstanding individuals and carry out the mission of LLTC by providing quality higher education grounded in Anishinaabe values.

### VISION

The vision of the Leech Lake Tribal College Student Princess and Brave Program is to enhance the LLTC vision of becoming recognized as a center of academic excellence. The LLTC Student Princess and Brave Program will provide an opportunity to individuals to gain additional life experience, increase personal and professional skills, and to develop performance-related & other talents; while illustrating to concerned constituents the importance of tradition and recruitment/retention primarily at powwows and other events that involve the community, school functions, etc.

### **REQUIRED COMPETITIONS:**

All participants will be critiqued and awarded points on the following areas:

30 points -	Interview	
30 points -	Essay	
20 points -	Dance Competition	
10 points -	Grades and Attendance	
10 points -	<b>Community Involvement</b>	
100 points total		

### **INTERVIEW: 30 POINTS**

The interview will be your opportunity to tell us about yourself, ideas, dancing, goals, and whatever else you want to share. You will gain valuable interviewing skills and practice. There are no right or wrong answers.

### ESSAY: 30 POINTS

Each participant will have the chance to answer an essay question highlighting their strengths and ideas of what it means to be a Student Princess or Brave. You are encouraged to include your family's input and support.

### DANCE COMPETITION: 20 POINTS

Every participant will be asked to introduce themselves before the dance competition. There will be a minimum of 2 songs to dance to throughout the powwow. In the event of a tie, those two will be required to dance to 1 additional song to break the tie.

### **GRADES & ATTENDANCE: 10 POINTS**

Your school official will complete the "Grade & Attendance Verification Form" stating that you: 1) Have not missed more than 15% of all classes (not including excused absences.) 2) Have a minimum 2.0 GPA

### COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT: 10 POINTS

This is your opportunity to demonstrate your community involvement by listing the information on the application forms or presenting your involvement during the interview.

### Awards/Prizes

The Student Princess and Brave will represent Leech Lake Tribal College at powwows throughout the community and special events in the area. The female Student Princess will receive a beaded crown and sash and the male Student Brave will receive a beaded choker, headband, and sash.

# **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AND GUIDELINES FOR RECIPIENTS AGREEMENT**

### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

Student must have a GPA of a 2.0 or higher Attending School: K-12

## GUIDELINES FOR THE CHOSEN PRINCESS AND BRAVE

- 1. You must have a responsible adult to accompany you to organizational meetings, activities, parades, fund-raisers and other scheduled appearances.
- 2. You will be responsible for the costs of travel, whenever possible we would like for you to attend the same powwows as the LLTC Recruiter.
- 3. You must be drug, alcohol and tobacco free; any misconduct will result in disqualification from the remainder of your reign.
- 4. You must have the willingness to dance at all powwows and scheduled events.
- 5. You must be willing to speak in public.
- 6. You must be willing, by your behavior, to represent Leech Lake Tribal College in the best possible manner.
- 7. You are expected to show good judgment and not participate in activities that would bring adverse publicity to yourself or Leech Lake Tribal College.
- 8. Consequences for misconduct will include, but are not limited to, verbal warnings, and in severe cases, removal of title and crown permanently. The Committee reserves the right to discuss and administer the consequences for misconduct.
- 9. There may be other requirements not mentioned in these guidelines. If other requirements are imposed, you will be notified in advance and will be required to follow them.
- 10. You will be provided with a sash and a crown/choker at no cost to you to wear during your reign and they will be yours to keep if you complete your one year reign.
- 11. Should the Princess or Brave become unable, unwilling, or ineligible to fulfill their duties, they must notify the LLTC-RP committee so that the runner-up may take over.
- 12. The winner will be selected and announced during the annual LLTC Powwow in May at the Veteran's Memorial Grounds in Cass Lake, MN.
