Second Degree Application & Requirements

A student seeking a second degree must be admitted to the second degree program through the readmission process. To apply for a second degree, visit the Admission's Office to complete the appropriate applications. The student must have successfully completed 12 credit hours in one semester to be eligible for a second degree.

A student seeking a second degree will be referred to the office of the Registrar. Approval for a second degree must be obtained from both the Registrar and Financial Aid Director. The Registrar will determine the number of credits needed for the second degree and the Financial Aid Director will determine the number of eligible financial aid credits. The student will be admitted if eligible for financial aid; if not eligible, the student must set up a payment plan with the Finance office.
