

The placement testing/assessment is an advising tool used by Student Services to test all new students, with the exceptions of:

- Transfer students that have completed passing credits in college level Math and/or English.
- Returning students who have completed passing credits in college level Math and/or English.
- Have taken ACT/SAT.

If it has been more than 5 years since you have completed passing credits, you may need to take the Accuplacer test.
