The AIHEC-American Indian Measures for Success (AIMS) project has two goals: to define relevant quantitative and qualitative indicator data of American Indian student success, as determined by the tribal colleges, and to develop and implement a strategy for collecting, analyzing, and presenting annually the success indicator data using electronic information management tools. Through data collection and analysis, this project will be the foundation for systemic reform that significantly increases - and for the first time, accurately measures - American Indian success in higher education.
