

Hansen's Forest Ecology Scholarship

Purpose: To provide a scholarship to deserving Leech Lake Tribal College Student/s enrolled in the Indigenous Science emphasis Forest Ecology Program. The Forest Ecology was endowed the by David Hansen family

Award Components: One (1) **\$1,000** scholarship will be awarded to a current LLTC student who will be returning as a full time Indigenous Science emphasis Forest Ecology student at LLTC for the Fall 2022 semester.

Indigenous Science Associate of Arts Degree, with an emphasis in Forest Ecology

Indigenous Science emphasis in Forest Ecology Program is a two-year course of study designed for students to receive an Associate in Art Degree (A.A.) upon completion of the requirements. Gikenimindwaa Mitigoog translates to 'getting to know the trees,' an apt description for a program which provides graduates with broad-based field knowledge of forest lands, the organisms inhabiting them and the systems (soil, water, air) that support them. Students complete coursework designed to develop an understanding of natural systems, examine human impacts and interactions, and practice relevant field and technical skills. The Indigenous Science emphasis in Forest Ecology program is intended for students with an interest in plant communities, water, forestry, wildlife, and fisheries and/or recreation management.

DEADLINE for applications is Friday, April 29 2022 by 4:00 PM

Recipient of this scholarship will be announced at graduation, in news publications, and/or on social media platforms.

NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student for the Fall 2022 semester upon evidence of enrollment at the Leech Lake Tribal College and satisfactory academic standing.

Criteria:

1. Applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student at the Leech Lake Tribal College for the upcoming Fall 2022 semester.
2. Applicant must have a GPA of 2.5 or Higher.
3. Applicant must be currently enrolled in or have a demonstrated interest in the LLTC, Forest Ecology program.

Additional Preferred Criteria (not required):

4. Additional consideration will be given to a student that demonstrates both the potential and desire to start a career in the Forest Ecology field.

In the event that the above criteria cannot be met, a student may be selected that most closely fits the above criteria.
