Instead, HP has designed a simple button combination that accomplishes the same task. The exact button varies by model, but it is often the WiFi button, the network status button, or a button with an "i" symbol on it-

Even after following the reset and setup procedures correctly, you might encounter a hiccup. One of the most frequent issues is simply typing the password incorrectly, which is why it is important to double-check the case and keyboard layout you are using-
